Truck movements are one way trips. Travelling in is considered one truck movement, travelling out with a load of water is considered one truck movement.

* TSC advised that both Lots 1 and 2 are operating concurrently. Lot 1 uses Shoobridge semi-trailers, 15 to 19 metres in length. According to their Development Application they should be small 6 metre trucks only.

** Estimates of truck movements put the weekly amount to 20 semi-trailer tankers.

The total truck movements amount to 166 laden trucks. Each semi-trailer tanks holds 28,200 litres. B-double tankers (used at Kynnumboon) hold 38,000 litres. Feel free to do the arithmetic.
